



1 + 1 AA degree completion for UHS

This is a tentative plan for UHS students to complete one year of an Associate of Arts degree in high school, then enroll at Sandburg for another year to complete the degree, and then transfer on to Monmouth College. Courses may be switched out based on availability of instructors or student preference.

This is a plan for the **AA degree only**. Students who desire an AS degree must meet with a Sandburg academic advisor to develop an individual plan. There is no guarantee an UHS student could complete an AS degree within the 1 + 1 program due to availability of classes.

UHS students will take these courses online, at Sandburg’s campus, or at UHS depending on instructor availability. Students taking dual credit courses must meet Sandburg admissions standards and complete the steps to enroll.
