The LPN TO ADN Articulation pathway offers the Licensed Practical Nurse with an active Illinois license in good standing the educational mobility to advance their educational and nursing practice level to that of a Registered Professional Nurse. We offer an articulation program that can be completed in one year that will provide the student, upon successful completion, an Associate in Applied Science degree and eligibility to take the National Council Licensure Examination – NCLEX-RN to become a Registered Professional Nurse.

The demand for nurses is high and is expected to increase.

Admission to the program is competitive and selection is based on a point system (www.sandburg.edu/nursing). Your point count is confidential and may be discussed by appointment with the Dean of the College of Nursing. All prospective students must meet all conditional admission requirements before applications will be considered for full admission. Applicants who are residents of the Carl Sandburg College district will be given first preference for admission. Attendance at an Informational Session is required.

Attend Informational Sessions

Applicants who receive conditional admission status are required to attend one of the information sessions conducted by the Dean of the College of Nursing and Health Professions. The program and admission process are discussed during these sessions. The scheduled times for these sessions can be obtained by calling the program office at 309-341-5299 or 309-341-5456.

Application Deadline - Fall 2016

Applications for Fall 2016 admission are accepted from October 1, 2015 through March 1, 2016. Conditional admission selection will occur March 15, 2016.

- Complete and submit on-line Nursing Application
- \$50 non-refundable ADN application fee (pay to Business Office)
- Meet with Advisor
- Make Appointment to take TEAS test (if applicable)
- Upon notification of conditional admittance (via e-mail), attend required informational session
- Pay \$50 seat fee for program
