LPN to RN Articulation into Nursing AAS – Admission Selection Criteria & Points

The LPN to RN Articulation into Nursing AAS has limited enrollment and a selection process for admission into the program. After all eligibility requirements for placement into the selection pool have been satisfied and applicant has applied online for the LPN to RN Articulation into Nursing AAS, the following point system will be utilized for selection into the program. The maximum number of points is 38. Conditional admission is offered to the top scorers in ranking order in each college district based on seats available. All other applicants are placed on an alternate list in ranking order.
