## LPN to RN Articulation - Associate Degree Nursing Program - Admission Selection Points Worksheet

- A College cumulative grade point average is calculated by all points earned and divided by hours attempted for all college level course work you have taken. An official transcript(s) must accompany your application.
- Points based on your <u>valid</u> ACT, SAT, or TEAS score. **Note: TEAS scores are valid for** <u>2</u> years. SAT and ACT scores are valid for <u>5</u> years.
- The point value you select should be based on the highest grade you received in the specified course. BIO 111, BIO 211, BIO 212, MDT 100 are Carl Sandburg College course numbers. See the Carl Sandburg College Course Catalog for course descriptions. \* All science courses must not have been taken more than (7) years prior to the time of application.
- This is where you total up the points you have earned in sections A-E (Note the maximum allowed for each section).

Minimum of 8 points required.

- Points are based on previous college level course work and college degree.
  - Student must have evidence of satisfactory academic progress in order to be eligible for financial aid consideration for the program (if a student is on suspension from Carl Sandburg, they are not eligible).
