



2023 GREGG CHADWICK STUDENT SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP

The Illinois Community College Trustees Association's **GREGG CHADWICK STUDENT SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP** provides a \$500 scholarship to a currently enrolled Illinois community college student for extraordinary commitment to volunteer service.

AWARD CRITERIA

Each nomination for the Gregg Chadwick Student Service Scholarship will be reviewed according to the following criteria:

- How does this student stand out, serving as a strong role model for others and engaging others in community service?
- Have the student's efforts made a lasting or meaningful contribution or impact on the college or community?
- How much time has this student devoted to community service during their college enrollment?
- How has the student's volunteer work been recognized and valued by their peers and community leaders?

NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS

All currently enrolled students at ICCTA member colleges are eligible to participate in the Gregg Chadwick Student Service Scholarship competition. Each college may submit one entry per academic year.

In order for a nomination to be considered, all of the following items must be included in the nomination packet.

The total length must not exceed six (6) single-sided pages:

- Letter of support from the college board of trustees
- Responses to each of the above award criteria questions
- Self-statement of 250 words or less describing how the nominee's life has been shaped by community service
- Optional supplemental materials (i.e., resumé, news articles, brochures, photos)

In addition, the nomination must include a narrative statement (not to exceed 150 words) that explains the nominee's qualifications and is suitable for use in ICCTA publicity materials. *The narrative statement is not included in the 6-page nomination packet, but it is required for a nomination to be considered.*

★ Failure to follow these guidelines will result in the disqualification of a nomination ★

PROGRAM DEADLINES

All nominations must be received **BY 5 PM, FRIDAY, MARCH 31, 2023. THIS DEADLINE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.** The statewide recipient of the Gregg Chadwick Student Service Scholarship will be presented with the \$500 stipend at ICCTA's June 2, 2023 awards banquet in Normal.
