

POLICY 2.27: TITLE IX

Title IX is a portion of the Education Amendments of 1972 with an emphasis on equal opportunities in education. In accordance with this law, Sandburg prohibits the discrimination of any person from participation or being denied benefits in any educational program or activity receiving federal assistance on the basis of race, color, religious affiliation, gender (sex), sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, national origin, ancestry, genetic information, age, disability, arrest record status, marital or family status, citizenship status, military status, unfavorable military discharge, sexual harassment, order of protection status and status in any group protected by applicable federal, state and/or local laws.
