

POLICY 2.60: PREVAILING WAGE

The provisions of the Prevailing Wage Act are compiled within all applicable work to be performed at the college (IL. Rev. Stat., Ch. 48, Par. 39s-1, et seq.).

Bid specifications and the call for bids for such contract work will specify that:

- The general prevailing rate of wages in the locality for each craft or type of worker or mechanic needed to execute the contract or perform such work and the general prevailing rate for legal holidays and overtime work, as ascertained by the board or by the Illinois Department of Labor, will be paid for each craft or type of worker needed to execute the contract or to perform such work.
- 2. It shall be mandatory upon the contractor to whom the contract is awarded and upon any subcontractor, to pay not less than the specified rates to all laborers, workers and mechanics employed in the execution on the contract of such work.

The contract for such work shall also contain a stipulation to the effect that not less than the prevailing rate of wages as found by the board, or the Illinois Department of labor, or the court on review shall be paid to all laborers, workers and mechanics performing work under the contract. It will also be required in all contractors' bonds that the contractors include such provision as will guarantee the faithful performance of such prevailing wage clause as provided by contract (IL.Rev.State.,Ch.48,par.39s-4).

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
