

POLICY 2.67: SANDBURG ARTWORK

Sandburg displays artwork — both owned and on loan — throughout the college campuses.

Artwork

All artwork selection and display decisions are proposed by the art program coordinator and approved by the dean of transfer. Artwork is defined as a physical object that may have an aesthetic and/or conceptual value. This could be a painting, a sculpture, a photograph, an installation, a drawing, a collage, etc. Physical plant serves as the only group who hangs or installs artwork with approval from the vice president of institutional resources.

Art gallery installations fall within either art-related classroom work or the art program coordinator specifically, and don't pertain to this policy. Placement and hanging of instructional-related items/materials are not governed by this policy and should be approved through the dean of the respective area prior to approval by the chief of academic services.
