

PROCEDURE 2.7.0: UNATTENDED CHILDREN

Sandburg strives to maintain a college community environment that fosters learning, encourages academic endeavor, and provides safety for students and all persons using college facilities. To ensure the safety of children on campus premises, no child under the age of 16 may be left unattended by an adult under any circumstances within any of the buildings and/or on any grounds of Sandburg.

To enforce this regulation, college representatives may ask a parent or guardian to take immediate custody of his or her child, call campus security to help resolve violations, or refer matters of significant endangerment to the vice president of student development or designee to take further appropriate action to address the circumstances of the situation and to ensure the safety and well-being of the child.
