  - o Design Build work is underway for new athletic facility
- This study will be for the Galesburg Campus only. Is the total square footage of the main campus known?

- Is the preference to utilize Carl Sandburg staff to open existing electrical equipment for inspection, or should the selected contractor plan to self-perform/subcontract that portion?

- Is there a preferred structure for billing, or preferred format to see the fee proposal?
