Associate Degree Nursing Program – Admission Selection Points Worksheet

The Associate Degree Nursing Program has limited enrollment and a selection process for admission into the Program. After all admission eligibility requirements for placement into the selection pool have been satisfied and the applicant has applied online for the Associate Degree Nursing Program, the Nursing Program uses the following point system for selection into the program. Top scorers receive conditional admission in ranking order based on the seats available. We place all other eligible applicants on an alternate list in ranking order. If students have the exact total point count, we will rank them according to the date/time the Nursing application was submitted.

See the Carl Sandburg College Course Catalog for course descriptions. * ***All Science courses must not have been taken more than (7) years before the time of application (BIO.200, BIO.211, and BIO.212)***
- D. This is where you total the points earned in sections A-C. (Note the maximum allowed for each section.)

A minimum of 4 points is required to be considered for the program.

- Students must have evidence of satisfactory academic progress to be eligible for financial aid consideration for the program (if a student is suspended from Carl Sandburg, they are not eligible).
