KOCC PARENT AGREEMENT 2026

To help ensure your child has a positive experience at Sandburg, **parental consent is required** regarding the following rules:

- I agree to pick up my child promptly after class.
- I give permission to Sandburg to video or photograph my child, relinquish all photographic rights and give permission to Sandburg, Sandburg's Community Education and Marketing departments to use my child's likeness as they deem appropriate.

- I won't hold Sandburg or college personnel/agents responsible in the event of an accident or injury.
- I understand Sandburg isn't responsible for lost/damaged property.
- I understand Sandburg personnel aren't permitted to hold or administer any medication.
- I understand Sandburg may suspend or terminate my child from the program for any reason that's deemed harmful or disruptive to the other participants or for just cause. Refunds won't be granted if a child is suspended or terminated.
