Carl Sandburg College is a public institution of higher education that is open to the general public. However, the College has the ability and authority to determine the expectations and parameters for an individual's presence on College property. The College retains the right to restrict access to College property due to safety considerations relating to its students, faculty, staff and visitors.

When it is determined that an individual presents a threat to the safety, security, or well-being of the campus or any individuals thereon, the College may issue a No Trespass Notice restricting that person from any property owned or controlled by the College for a period of time to be determined on a case-by-case basis. Failure to comply with the Notice will result in arrest pursuant to 720 ILCS 5/21-5, or any applicable city/county ordinance.
