The Board of Trustees shall have only one standing committee, the committee of the whole. Individual Board members may be delegated quasi-official supervising functions in areas of special interest, but they shall have no legal authority to act for the Board.

Special committees may be established for fact-finding or service purposes. Their actions are subject to approval by the Board as a whole, and they shall be disbanded as soon as their specific task is completed.

The chief executive officer of the College, with the approval of the Chairman of the Board of Trustees, may call meetings of special Board committees and shall attend all committee meetings, and all Board meetings, except when his employment or salary is under consideration.
