All courses listed above must be chosen from the approved degree plan. This is a suggested plan and students must meet with an academic advisor to establish their individualize plan. Based on Accuplacer placement scores, additional preparatory courses may be required before the student can begin some of the college level courses.

Any extra credit hours in a certain category, will carry down to electives. For example, if a student takes eight hours of math and only six hours are required, the extra two hours will carry down to the elective category. Students may not have as many elective classes as listed on the outline due to the math and science courses having a higher number of credit hours.

The total credit hours for the AS degree is 61.
To meet most transfer school requirements, it is suggested that the student take an additional Humanities/Fine Arts and Social Science class as electives.
