**Electives** – There are a variety of courses that can meet the elective requirement. The student will work with a Sandburg academic advisor to select the courses that meet this requirement.

**Illinois Articulation Initiative (IAI)** is a statewide transfer agreement which facilitates transfer among more than 100 participating colleges and universities in Illinois. The IAI General Education Core Curriculum (GECC) includes the following categories:

## Communication: 3 courses or 9 credit hours

Humanities and Fine Arts: 3 courses total, 1 course must be a Humanities course, 1 course must be a Fine Arts course. The additional course is the student's choice or as directed by the advisor. **Social and Behavioral Sciences:** 3 courses or 9 credits total. Courses must be from 3 different subject areas.

**Mathematics:** 1 course (3-5 credit hours)

**Physical Science and Life Sciences:** 2 courses total, 1 course form each area (7-8 credit hours). One of the courses must have a lab.

Human Relations: 1 course or 3 credit hours.
