

## TRANSFER STUDENT INFORMATION

### For Carl Sandburg College Students

- All transfer credit to Augustana College must be earned with a grade of C or better.
- A minimum of 60 semester hours must be earned at Augustana College, excluding HPE courses.
- A maximum of 40 credits with the same subject code may apply toward graduation. Courses listed under more than one course code are counted toward the limit under each code.
- A maximum of 9 semester credits earned through distance education offered by an accredited undergraduate institution may be applied toward the Bachelor of Arts degree. Distance education includes but is not limited to 2-way audio/2-way video, open broadcast TV courses, and correspondence courses.

If a student enrolled at Augustana College wishes to return to Carl Sandburg College to take one or more courses, there is an approval process required by Augustana College. Students should contact the Registrar's Office at Augustana College to initiate the approval process.

\_\_\_ Completion of one 200-level course at Augustana College
